

Terms and Conditions of Mill Farm Fishery

Please observe our fishing rules:-

1. Mill Farm Fishery gives the opportunity for varied fishing so we would recommend that you bring along a variety of tackle and bait.
2. Mill Farm Lake is stocked annually with trout and special rules apply. These are posted by the entrance gate to Mill Lake but please note that fishing on this lake from 1st February to 31st March is strictly fly only, with barbless hooks. Furthermore, until 1st April it is 100% catch and release. After that you may kill one trout only in any day.
3. All anglers over the age of 12 must have a current Environmental Agency License and a permit from Gilling Old Mill. Licenses and permits may be liable for inspection by EA Officers/members whilst fishing.
4. All anglers must obtain from Gilling Old Mill a permit
5. There is to be no arrival before 7 am
6. Anglers must leave no later than one hour after sunset
7. There is to be no more than 1 kg cereal ground bait allowed
8. All children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult whilst fishing.
9. All litter including discarded line, hooks shot etc must be picked up and taken away by the angler. Tins – food/drink/bait are banned
10. No barbed hooks, barbless or debarbed hooks only to be used.
11. Rods must not be left unattended at any time
12. No discarding of bait on the bank or in the lakes
13. Care and consideration should be given to wildlife and other anglers at all times.
14. All gates must be closed at all times
